

The Additional Chief Engineer briefly described the context of the meeting and requested the Project Director of WeCARE Phase-I: LGED to discuss the technical issues of the Bids.

The Project Director discussed about the background of invited bid. Then the discussion started on the major issues of the requirements of the bids, eligible and qualifications criteria. Section III and VI of the Bid Documents elaborately discussed, Fraud & Corruption issues was also discussed and made the bidders' awareness. Then the floor was opened to receive questions from the bidders.

Exchange Rates Consideration during Bidder's Qualifications Express & Evaluate:

Wherever a Bidder is required to state a monetary amount, Bidders should indicate the USD equivalent using the rate of exchange determined as follows:

- For construction turnover or financial data required for each year Exchange rate prevailing on the last day of the respective calendar year (in which the amounts for that year is to be converted) was originally established.
- Value of single contract Exchange rate prevailing on the date of the contract.

Exchange rates shall be taken from the publicly available source identified in the ITB 32.1. Any error in determining the exchange rates in the Bid may be corrected by the Employer.

Copy Requirements:

In addition to the original of the Bid, the number of copies is: 1 (One) hard copy and 1 (One) electronic copy.

The electronic copy in Adobe Acrobat format should be submitted on a CD, DVD, or flash drive inside the envelope for Original Bid.
