1. Well being and target HH selection criteria

I. Very well off

- Land holding ----
- Holding lease ----
- Very well construct house
- Have good job
- Regular good amount of savings
- Run good business
- Received regular remittance
- Have a good number of livestock and other HH assets have increasing liquidity value
- Have TV. Motorcycle, motorized boat, even car
- Have considerable capacity to overcome any natural shocks or serious diseases/mishaps
- Socially and politically influential

II. Well off/Middle class

- land holding
- Lease holding
- Quite a good house
- Have job earning around/year
- Have minimum regular savings
- Run some business
- Received some amount of remittance
- Have few livestock and some other valuable household assets
- Have TV, radio, boat etc

- Have some capacity to overcome natural shocks and diseases
- Have some social and political influence

III. Small farmer

- Land holding >2.5 acre-7 acre
- No lease holding
- Poorly built house
- Very small amount of irregular savings
- Have to take loan for investment
- Have very few livestock
- Hardly any capacity to overcome natural shocks and diseases
- No social influence

IV. Marginal farmer

- Land holding <2,5 acre
- No lease holding
- Poorly built house
- No Savings
- Have to take loan for investment and sometime for living as well
- Have very few livestock
- Have no such capacity to overcome natural shocks and diseases like phenomenon
- No social influence

V. Poor farmer Landless

- No land apart from homestead
- No lease holding
- Very poorly built house
- No savings
- Have to take loan regularly for living
- Have some chicken or ducks
- Have no capacity to overcome natural shocks and diseases like phenomenon
- Socially absolute marginal

2. Other criteria for selecting targeted HH

Full time professional fisher

- Fisher catches fish over the year for marketing/business

Occasional/Parttime fisher

- Fisher only seasonally catches fish for selling

Subsistence fisher

- People have no ability to buy, but catch fish mainly for consumption

Indigent women

- Deserted by husband
- Household head
- Have no land, apart from a small piece of homestead
- Dependent on other people's assistance
- Have to beg to meet food and clothing
- Have no occupation skill

Pro people/Local champions

- Socially and politically influential
- Well respected by community
- Have past track record of pro people activities
- Have good knowledge on beel resource management
- Have hardly any interest in leasing

Local youth identified as field assistant

- At least secondary school certificate passed
- Belong to a socially good family
- The family is well accepted by the local people
- Interested in social work
- Have a good track record of hard working
- Well behaved
- Good in communicating people
- Know riding on cycle
- Willing to work irrespective of day and night
