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I. INTRODUCTION

A. Background

1. The Asian Development Bank (ADB) supported Coastal Towns Infrastructure Environmental Infrastructure Project (CTEIP) in 10 coastal towns, that effectively commenced on September 2014 with scheduled completion on June 2022. As a continuity of the CTEIP project, ADB extended its support to Coastal Towns Climate Resilience Project (CTCRP) which will strengthen climate resilience and disaster preparedness in 22 (twenty-two) vulnerable coastal *Pourashavas* (secondary municipal towns) of Bangladesh. The towns were selected based on their vulnerability, population size, density, and level of past investments. The project takes a holistic and integrated approach to urban development and will (i) provide climate-resilient municipal infrastructure, and (ii) strengthen institutional capacity, local governance, and knowledge-based public awareness, for improved urban planning and service delivery considering climate change and disaster risks. Key infrastructure investments include (i) drainage, (ii) water supply, (iii) sanitation, (iv) cyclone shelters, and (v) other municipal infrastructure including emergency access roads and bridges, solid waste management, bus terminals, slum improvements, boat landings, and markets. Investments will benefit the poor and women. The MLGRDC acting through its Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) will be the Executing Agency. *Pourashavas* are the implementing agencies of the project.

2. Coastal towns are particularly at risk from the impacts of climate change due to high levels of poverty and limited capacity of *Pourashavas* (urban local governments) to invest in resilience. The *Pourashavas* lack resilient infrastructure, clubbed with haphazard urbanization, lack of stormwater drains, poor solid waste management system further worsens the condition of these towns. Most of the coastal towns are situated on the riverbanks of low-lying tidal zones at an average elevation of 1.0–1.5 meters (m) from the sea level¹ and coastal flooding is a key hazard faced by these towns. Inadequate basic municipal infrastructure to respond to increasing climate risk threatens both quality of life and the economic growth of coastal towns. This calls for an integrated approach for coastal town development that promotes risk-informed planning and investment for building resilience.

B. Project Description

3. **Output 1: Municipal infrastructure for resilience improved.** Output 1 will support to develop priority municipal infrastructure and essential services that are critical for improving climate and disaster resilience and local economic development in 22 project towns². Output 1 includes (i) elderly (older persons), women, children, and persons with disabilities friendly cyclone shelters constructed with early warning system; (ii) emergency access road to cyclone shelter upgraded or constructed; (iii) climate resilient infrastructure for improved urban flood risk management such as stormwater drainages, nature-based solutions, water bodies restoration, and integrated waste management (IWM) developed; (iv) roads with stormwater drainages, bridges and culverts rehabilitated or constructed for improved connectivity and access to emergency services in the event of disasters triggered by natural hazards; (v) gender responsive and socially inclusive urban public spaces improved; (vi) slum improvement program implemented; and (vii) Elderly (older persons), women, children, and persons with disabilities (EWCD)-friendly sanitation facilities constructed for poor households. Output 1 will also support development of EWCD-friendly socioeconomic infrastructures

including (i) local markets; (ii) bus terminals; and (iii) other priority roads, bridges, culverts, and boat landing stations.

4. **Output 2: Resilient livelihoods enhanced.** Output 2 includes: (i) climate vulnerable households covered in the graduation program in six project towns; (ii) training of women, including person with disabilities, to increase skills for resilient livelihood; and (iii) documenting vulnerable households' inventories of productive assets and facilitating access to insurance. This will also aid poor and vulnerable households from the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.³

5. **Output 3: Institutional capacity, governance, and climate-awareness strengthened.** Output 3 includes (i) risk-informed urban development plans and poverty reduction action plans of project towns submitted to *Pourashavas* council and ensuring development activities aligning with the risk-informed urban development plans; (ii) training of staff of LGED and *Pourashavas*, including 90% of eligible women staff, for increased knowledge on GESI-responsive climate and disaster risk assessment to inform urban development plans and development control regulations linked with hazards; (iii) training of LGED and *Pourashava* staff, including 90% of eligible women staff, for increased knowledge and capacity on green and nature-based solutions (NbS); (iv) the operationalization of disaster management committee on disaster preparedness measures, cyclone shelter management committees, and standing committees on women and children's affairs, poverty reduction and slum improvement in project *Pourashavas* for improving municipal governance and sustainable service delivery; (v) adapting revenue enhancement plan by each project *Pourashava*; (vi) the establishment of functioning computerized tax records and billing systems; (vii) the approval of annual Gender Equality and Social Inclusion (GESI)-responsive operations and maintenance manual (O&M) plans by each project *Pourashava* and allocation and spending of at least 75% of the required annual budget; and (viii) developing GESI - responsive and socially inclusive urban space guidelines . Output 3 also supports enhanced public awareness, behavior change, and community mobilization in light of emergencies such as the COVID-19 pandemic and cyclone Amphan in 2020. It will also support training and capacity building of LGED and *Pourashavas* to institutionalize information technology-based remote monitoring through strengthening LGED's geographic information systems section, monitoring, and evaluation unit, and PMU.

C. Implementation Arrangements

6. The MLGRDC acting through its LGED is the Executing Agency. The Project Management Unit (PMU) at the LGED is headed by a Project Director (PD), who is supported by two Deputy Project Directors (DPDs) overseeing safeguards and gender. Deputy Project Director (Executive Engineer) CTCRP will be the Safeguard focal person from PMU. At PMU level, project staff (LGED engineers) are in place, however they are not properly designated yet. The safeguard and gender team will have three safeguard and gender personnel, Assistant Director (Environment), Assistant Director (Social Safeguards) and Assistant Director (Gender). For project implementation, two division level Regional Project Management Units (RPMUs) will be established, at Khulna and Barisal. The RPMUs were scheduled to be established by December 2023 but as of 30 June 2024 RPMUs have not been established. The Development Project Proforma which include approval of the RPMU is still under review; hence, the setting up of RPMUs (Khulna and Barisal) is still pending. Two divisional Engineers will sit at divisional level (One at Barisal and another at Khulna). *Pourashavas* are the implementing agencies of the project. The PMU will be supported by three institutional consultants under the supervision and control of Project Director, PMU: (i) the detailed design service consultants (DDSC); (ii) the project management supervision

consultants (PMSC) and Institutional capacity and community development consultants (ICCDC) that will support PMU; and (iii) the PMSC at the division level that will support the two RPMUs and the town-level PIUs. PMSC is not on board as of 30 June 2024. The 22 PIUs are already in place in each participating *Pourashava* subproject town and staffed with a safeguards and gender focal person.

D. Project Categorization

7. **Involuntary Resettlement (Category B).** The project is classified as category B for involuntary resettlement as per ADB's Safeguards Policy Statement (SPS) 2009. A resettlement framework has been prepared as a guidance document, for preparation of resettlement plans / resettlement and Tribes, Minor Races, Ethnic Sects and Communities plans (RTMRESCP), (termed as resettlement and small ethnic community plan in CTCRP) for subprojects that involves involuntary resettlement impacts or insignificant impacts to indigenous people/TMRESC. The CTCRP is assessed to involve mostly insignificant impacts (temporary income loss to road-side hawkers, vendors and shop owners and structure loss not resulting into relocation or less than 10% impact to income generating asset). The sample subprojects are assessed to involve (i) potentially significant impacts for 11 households (56 members), including 7 vulnerable households (38 members);⁴ insignificant impacts to 106 households (504 members) including 51 vulnerable households (289 family members) and loss of 268 trees. No category A subprojects are envisaged, and none will be implemented. The social safeguards planning documents will be updated during the final design and detailed measurement survey. The PMU has disclosed the resettlement plans, small ethnic communities (SEC) planning framework, resettlement and small ethnic communities plan (RSECP), and due diligence reports on the project's official website, and the documents will be available in the local language and disclosed to affected persons.⁵ The resettlement planning documents are included in the bidding documents and civil works contracts; it is ensured by the PMU.

8. **Indigenous peoples (category B).** The project is assessed category B for indigenous people/ Tribes, Minor Races, Ethnic Sects and Communities (TMRESC). A small ethnic communities planning framework document is prepared to guide the preparation of safeguard documents for subprojects that involves impacts on indigenous people. Kuakata, one of the subproject towns, reports the highest proportion of TMRESC (1.67% of the total population). TMRESC populations in the remaining project towns are scattered and integrated in urban society. In Kuakata, six TMRESC households (26 family members) are assessed to face insignificant temporary loss of income and loss of trees, while 25 TMRESC households (103 family members) will benefit due to project implementation.

E. Scope of the Report

9. The scope of the semi-annual social safeguard monitoring report (SSMR) is to present the periodic (semi-annually) update of the project implementation status in compliance with the ADB SPS, 2009, as per the approved resettlements plans/RSECP/DDR's). The list of disclosed social safeguard documents is provided in Table 1.

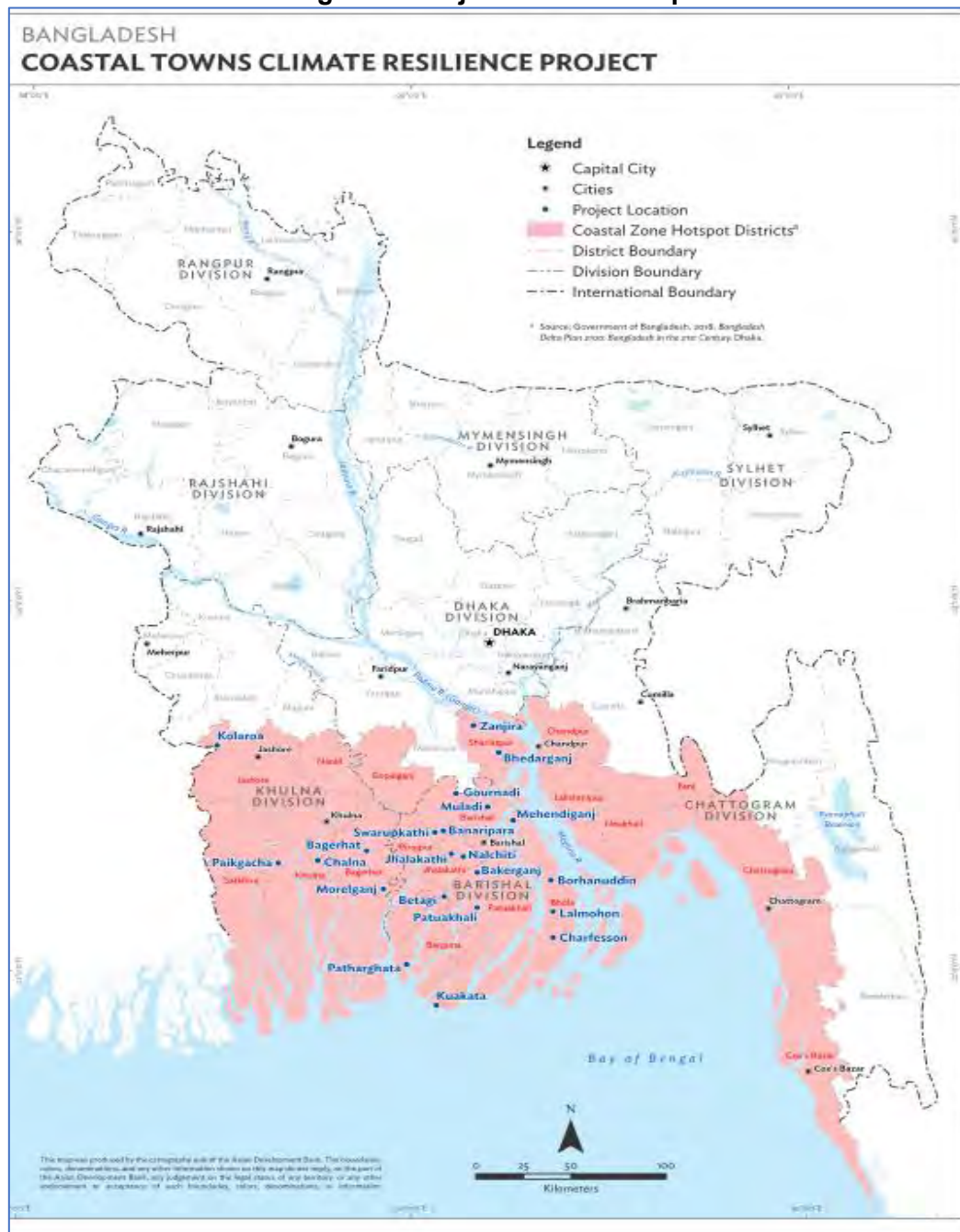

For cyclone shelters, the legal agreement between the Kuakata *Pourashava* and the Madrasah or School Managing Committee, which will formalize the arrangement will be signed and appended to the updated social safeguards documents and will also reported in the future SSMRs (see Appendix 3).

II. SCOPE OF INVOLUNTARY RESETTLEMENT IMPACT

A. Involuntary Resettlement Impact

11. Based on the impacts assessed and the socioeconomic survey of the affected persons; six resettlement plans⁸ and one resettlement and small ethnic communities plan⁹ were prepared and approved by ADB. As of date, the project (30 June 2024) is assessed to involve potentially significant impacts for 12 households (60 members), including 8 vulnerable households (42 members); insignificant impacts for 107 households (508 members), including 52 vulnerable households (293 members); and the loss of 268 trees. The proposed mitigation measures and safeguard planning documents for sample subprojects address these impacts adequately. No category A subprojects are envisaged, and none will be allowed. The social safeguards planning documents will be updated in case of design changes/modifications. The resettlement framework guides the preparation of resettlement planning documents. The PMU has disclosed the updated resettlement plans, small ethnic communities (SEC) planning framework, resettlement plan and tribes, minor races, ethnic sects and communities plan (RESCP) plan, and due diligence reports on the project's official website, and the documents will be summarized into a project information disclosure leaflet and will be made available in the local language and disclosed to affected persons.¹⁰ The resettlement planning documents are included in the bidding documents and civil works contracts.

12. The following are package-wise involuntary resettlement impacts are discussed below:

B. Status of Compensation Payment and Restoration/Rehabilitation

13. As of reporting period, the status of the 25 contracts have been awarded (detailed in **Table 2**). Out of which, construction work is ongoing 20 packages and while the remaining 5 packages have not yet commenced construction; however, conformity soil test, site clearing, materials mobilization are ongoing for these packages. The final impact assessment has been done before mobilization of contractor/s and compensation payment is ongoing for one subproject (see Table 4) as per the social safeguard documents.

C. Implementation Status of the TMRESC Community Specific Action Plan (for Kuakata Roads)

14. In Kuakata RD-01 subproject, small and medium size of trees were cut down Rakhain Community. The community benefits from the subproject through improved roads for easier movement and drainage to address waterlogging, enhancing overall road and drainage conditions. Consequently, the community is pleased with these improvements and has willingly declined compensation in favor of supporting the development project. Any structures or income not been affected or disrupted due to the improvement of the road. Before implementation of the subproject water logging were occurred during rainy season. After implementation of the subproject water logging has been removed and road communication system has been improved that is why the Rakhain Community are happy towards the project. No direct or indirect impact to the dignity, human rights, livelihood systems or natural or cultural resources of Rakhain community, is anticipated as the affected trees are not part of their cultural or religious practices. The overall impact to the community will be mostly beneficial, and the proposed road improvement is anticipated to benefit 25 Rakhain households (103 family members). The specific action plan ensures that project benefits to TMRESC are undertaken in a culturally appropriate manner. The status of the SAP is provided below:

III. DISCLOSURE, PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AND CONSULTATION

15. Public consultation meetings were held with the key stakeholders, during the project preparation and at the onset of project implementation. During the reporting period, public consultation meetings were held with *Madrasha* and high school authority and community people in line with the ADB's requirements pertaining to environmental, economic and social considerations (Appendix 1) were conducted in Kolaroa, Muladi, Patuakhali, Bagerhat, Betagi, Gouranadi, Kuakata, Swarupkathi, Chalna, Bakerganj, Nalcity, Jhalokathi, Borhanuddin, Charfession, Lalmohan, Zanjira, Patharghata and Bakerganj *Pourashavas*. Consultation with locals, key stakeholders helped in identifying the felt needs and apprehensions related to the project and their priorities. Subproject-wise venue, date and number of participants presented in **Table 6**.

16. The local people have expressed their greater interest for this cyclone shelter for their safety during disaster period and using this facility for education purpose. They have also assured that they will provide required support in construction, operations and maintenance of this cyclone shelter. *Pourashava* management and local community will be responsible for providing required services for construction, operation and maintenance of cyclone shelter. The services/uses of cyclone shelter will result in saving lives of local people and reduce damage to their properties that caused due to irregular disaster in this coastal area.

17. Efforts will be given to ensure female participation in consultation process during implementation phase. Special care will be taken to disseminate information to the community people regarding the cyclone center and its usefulness during disaster time. Provisions for separate toilet facilities for men and women have been considered in the design of the cyclone center. People around the nearby area of the cyclone center will get the best benefits during disaster period.

18. During the group discussion, it was clearly mentioned that the construction work will be undertaken in such a way that there will be no harm caused to any person or the existing school building due to project execution activity. The daily functioning of the school or academic session will not be disturbed. Project outcomes and benefits were explained to the

stakeholders. During the consultation, community people were explained in detail regarding the proposed developments of the plot under the ADB project. All the participants confirmed their extended support for the success of the project.

19. Public information campaigns to explain the project details to a wider population will be conducted throughout project lifecycle. Public disclosure meetings will be conducted at key project stages to appraise community members. Prior to start of construction, the PIU will issue notification on the start date of implementation in local newspapers. A notice board showing the details of the project will be displayed at the construction sites for the information of public.

20. Public participation will be generated through use of various methods, such as, stakeholder consultation meetings, FGDs with different groups (including women), key informant interviews etc. It is also expected to offer a platform to the community people in to (i) know about the program, and (ii) express their opinion regarding priorities and concerns related to the project.

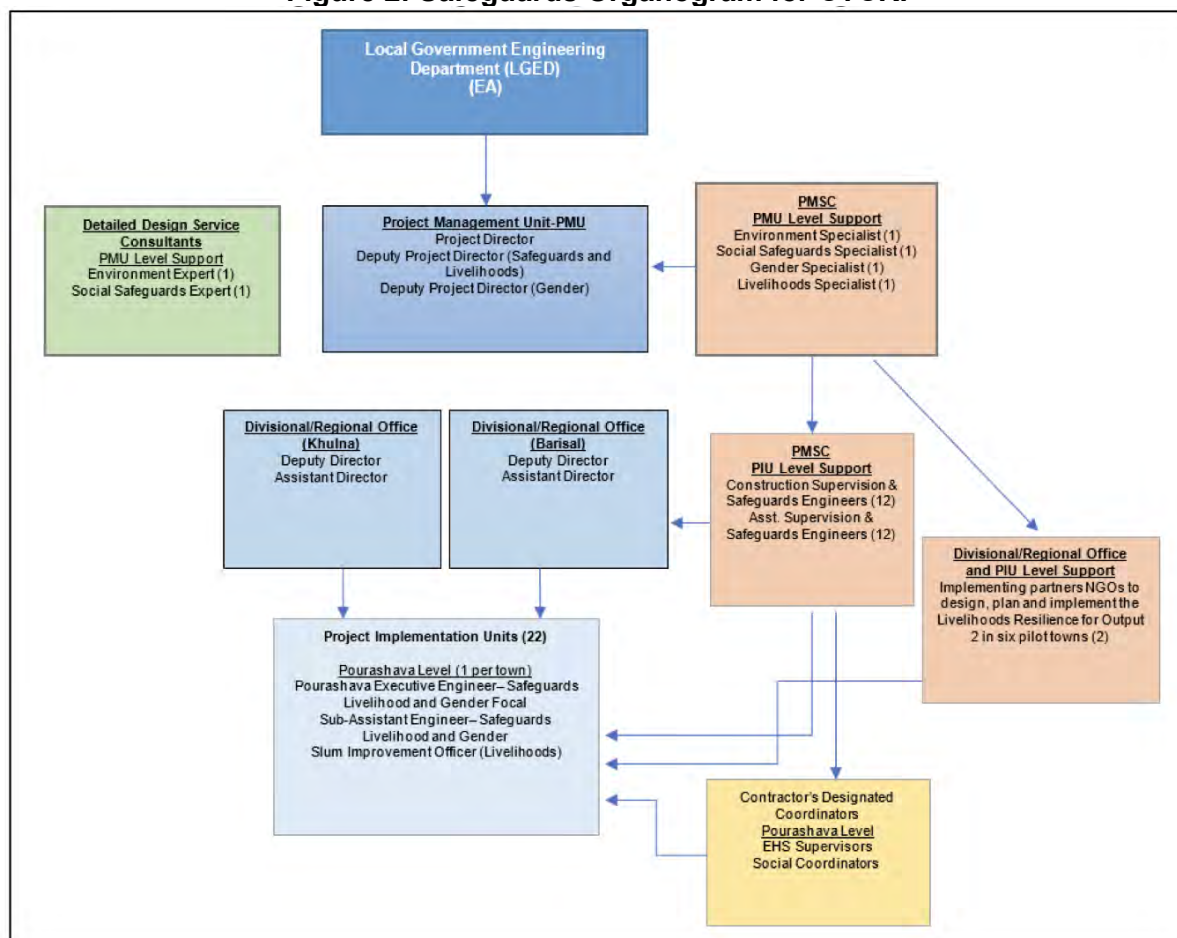
IV. GRIEVANCE REDRESS MECHANISM (GRM)

21. The project adopts a three-tier Grievance Redress Mechanism (GRM) for implementing the project. The GRM receives, evaluates, and facilitates the resolution of social, environmental, or other project-related grievances. The GRM will aim to provide a time-bound and transparent mechanism to voice and resolve social and environmental concerns linked to the project. The public awareness campaign will be conducted to ensure that awareness of the project and its grievance redress procedures is generated and shared with affected persons and other stakeholders. The campaign will ensure that the poor, vulnerable, and others are made aware of the need for and process in availing of the GRM. The list of GRC members is provided in Appendix 4.

22. No grievances have been recorded within the reporting period of this SSMR.

V. INSTITUTIONAL ARRANGEMENT

23. The MLGRDC acting through its LGED is the Executing Agency. Project Management Unit (PMU) at the LGED is headed by a Project Director (PD), who is supported by two Deputy Project Directors (DPDs) overseeing safeguards and livelihood, and gender. Deputy Project Director (Executive Engineer) CTCRP will be the Safeguard focal person from PMU. The safeguard and gender team will have three safeguard and gender personnel, Assistant Director (Environment), Assistant Director (Social Safeguards) and Assistant Director (Gender). For project implementation, two division level RPMUs will be established, at Khulna and Barisal. The RPMUs were scheduled for establishment by December 2023 but have not been set up because the DPP is currently under review. *Pourashavas* are the implementing agencies of the project. The PMU will be supported by institutional consultants under the supervision and control of Project Director, PMU: (i) the detail design service consultants (DDSC); (ii) the project management supervision consultants (PMSC), that will support PMU; (iii) Institutional capacity and community development consultants (ICCDC) that will support PMU, and (iii) PMSC at the division level that will support the two RPMUs and the town-level PIUs. PMSC is not on board as of 30 June 2024. The PIUs will be established in each participating *Pourashava*/ subproject town and staffed with a safeguards and gender focal person. A list of manpower at PMU and PIUs/*Pourashava* level is attached in Appendix 2.

VI. MONITORING RESULTS-FINDINGS

24. As of 30 June 2024, 48 (forty-eight) Social Safeguard Documents have been prepared for CTCRP. Out of which, 6 RPs 1 combined RP and IPP and 40 DDRs. RPs have been prepared for (i) Construction/Improvement of 4 Roads in Patharghata *Pourashava*, District Barguna Package No.: e-GP/CTCRP/ PATH/RD/01; (ii) Construction/Improvement of Roads and Roadside Drains in Jhalokathi *Pourashava*; (iii) Construction and Improvement of 19.83 km Bituminous Carpeting and Reinforced Concrete Cement Roads under 3 Packages: (i) e-GP/CTCRP/BAKR/RD-01 (ii) e-GP/CTCRP/BAKR/RD-02, and (iii) e-GP/CTCRP/BAKR/RD-03 in Bakerganj *Pourashava*, District: Barisal; (iv) Integrated Waste Management for Bagerhat *Pourashava*, District: Bagerhat; (v) Construction and Improvement of 5.557 km Reinforced Cement Concrete Drains in Bagerhat *Pourashava*, District: Bagerhat; and (vi) Construction and Improvement of 12.32 km RCC Drains Under 3 Packages: (i) CTCRP/PTK/21- 22/DR-01, (ii) CTCRP/PTK/21-22/DR-02 and (iii) CTCRP/PTK/21-22/DR-03) in Patuakhali *Pourashava*, District: Patuakhali. Combined RP and IPP (RSECP) was prepared for (i) Kuakata Town Roads Subproject, Kuakata *Pourashava*, District: Patuakhali. Detailed and specific information provided in the respective RPs/RSECP. Among the 40 DDRs, 18 prepared for Multipurpose Cyclone Shelter, 21 Construction of Road and Roadside Drains and 2 constructions of drains.

25. As of 30 June 2024, RPMUs have not been established in Khulna and Barisal Region. Because the DPP has been approved with the provision of 13 personnel for the PMU, excluding the RMPU. Therefore, there is no scope to establish of the RPMUs under the CTCRP.

26. In the reporting period, PMSC is not on board. After receiving ADB concurrence, PMU

initiated and letter sent to the Secretary of the Local Government Division on 11 March 2024 for approval. The negotiated contract price is higher than the DPP price. In this regards explanation seeking from the Planning Commission regarding this has led to delays in the approval process. Consequently, despite the file for the firm's appointment being with the Ministry due to changes in the officials of the relevant desk, approval has not yet been granted.

Discussion Made on FGD: SCTEIP-II Social Safeguard Expert and Resettlement Expert conducted Focus Group Discussion Meeting on 25/06/23. The FGD meeting was attended by a group of community people including local elites. The respective Ward Councillor presided over the meeting and Environmental Expert recorded the minutes including participants' attendance. The Surveyor of Pourashava also attended the meeting. The SCTEIP-II Consultant discussed on the following points of FGDs and invited the opinions of the participants.

A. Social Safeguard Issues:

- 1) Position of land and trees and its ownership;
- 2) Construction/improvement of roads;
- 3) Community support for constructing these schemes; and
- 4) Disseminate information about project implementation.

B. Emergency and Gender Development Issues:

- 5) . Contractors will employ women workers with same wage scale and safeguard facilities (gloves, apron, sanitation, tube well, workers' shed equal and separate facility for men and women at work site);
- 6) Orientation/Training Program for women groups/ workers/ women headed family heads to promote understanding of women about interrelationship between environment, sanitation, solid waste management, health and hygiene (facility) and its use;
- 7) Advance Emergency Warning System;
- 8) Community Mobilization Facilitator (CMF) must monitor contractor's assignments for Gender development issues. Proper documentation as per LGED reporting format; and
- 9) CMF must arrange gender awareness raising meetings with the TLCCs members at project /Ward level (a minimum 2 such meetings in a week)- as per LGED guideline/manual

A total number of 46 local persons attended the meeting. During question and answer session, the local people hoped that in case of impacts, the affected person will receive assistance by the project. The project discussed about entitlements for affected persons and emphasizes that the subproject will not cause resettlement impacts to the community. Additionally, measures will be implemented to avoid potential impacts.

The recommendation and suggestions of affected persons are as follows on the road schemes:

- They will be happy to have improved road communication'
- The participants opined to be happy to have improved road communication with improved road facility in the near future by the *Pourashava*;
- Engage local people to construction works by their capacity; and
- Construction works should be completed in dry season.

Discussion Made on FGD: CTCRP Social Safeguard Expert conducted a FGD session on 21 January 2024. Participants including the surveyor of Bagerhat *Pourashava*, respective Ward Councillor, local elites, people of various occupations from different locations of the proposed project area were attended in the FGD session and express views, concerns and suggestions on the proposed road to be constructed.

The Social Safeguards Expert of CTCRP discussed on the following issues during the FGDs session-

A. Social Safeguard Issues:

1. Position of land and trees and its ownership
2. Construction of road and roadside drainage system, cyclone shelter, water supply, sanitation, and other municipal infrastructures includes: access roads, bridges, solid waste management plant, bus terminal, slum improvements, boat landing/ ferry ghats, markets/growth centres, etc.;
3. Community support for constructing these schemes;
4. Benefits from these infrastructures' establishments by the community Workers Health and Safety; and
5. Disseminate information about proposed project implementation.

B. Emergency and Gender Development Issues:

structure will be three storied building with required facilities for women and children; there will be ramps to ground floor for wheelchair access to take care of people with disabilities. There will be separate toilet facilities.
