The Government of the Peoples' Republic of Bangladesh has applied for a credit from the International Development Association (IDA) in the amount of about US\$ 350 million equivalent toward the cost of the proposed Rural Transport Improvement Project (RTIP)-II and it intends to apply the proceeds of this credit to payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services to be procured under this project. The main components of the projects are improvement of rural infrastructure like upazila and union roads along with appurtenant structures, drainage structures on rural roads, growth centre markets, river jetties, rural

waterways etc. including procurements of equipment and consulting services for Design, Supervision, Monitoring and Management of the project. The details are stated below :

Goods :

The goods procurement under the proposed project may include vehicles, road construction equipment, survey equipment, ICT accessories and office equipment.

Works :

The works contracts will be scattered in different parts of 26 (eastern part of the river Jamuna including greater Pabna of Bangladesh) out of 64 districts of Bangladesh. The project is being designed to upgrade about 2500 km of Upazila Roads (UZRs) and Union Roads (URs) including critical bridges, cross drainage facilities and road safety issues; it will construct Flood Proof Upazila Road and flood refuse centers. The project will also include construction of 15,000 m of Structure on Rural Roads, Rehabilitation / Maintenance of 2,000 km of UZR including bridges/ culverts and improvement of about 150 numbers of growth center markets/rural markets. It also includes improvement of rural water routes of approximately 200 km length in order to connect places of importance like growth centers markets or other all weather roads or to feed larger waterways identified in Inland Water Transport (IWT) Master Plan and administered by Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Authority (BIWTA).

Services :

The services will include among others, Management Support Consultants (MSC), Design & Supervision Consultants (D&SC) and Institutional Strengthening and Capacity Building (ISCB) Consultants whose tasks will cover support to LGED for management of consultants and other project activities; feasibility, design of works and preparation of bidding documents (works & goods); supervision and monitoring of works and certification of bills of the contractors for works; and design and support to LGED to implement an institutional strengthening and capacity building program.

Procurement of contracts financed by the credit will be conducted through the procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines : Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits (May 2004 & revised October 2006 & May 2010) and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the guidelines. Consulting services will be selected in accordance with the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers (May 2004 & revised October 2006 & May 2010).

Specific procurement notices for contracts to be bid under the World Bank's International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures and large-value consultants' contracts will be announced, as they become available, in Development Business, dgMarket, website of the Central Procurement Technical Unit (CPTU) and in the national daily newspapers of Bangladesh.
