







The Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) is a public sector organization entrusted with the functions of developing, maintaining and managing rural, urban and small scale water resource infrastructures involving Local Government Institutions (LGIs), different communities and taking care of environmental, social and gender issues. Since inception, LGED has given utmost importance to improve the capacity of its employees through training. Training Calendar for the FY 2016-17 includes all training courses to be implemented under the revenue and development fund and achievement status for the last year (2015-16). I firmly believe that continuous training program will scale up knowledge, skill and attitude of employees of LGED and other stakeholders which ultimately will improve the standard of infrastructures and social services.

I sincerely appreciate the effort of Training Unit to prepare the Training Calendar, 2016-17 in collaboration with various officials, projects, experts and believe that it will be a guiding tool for capacity development program of LGED.

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Training is a systematic approach of developing manpower of the organization. LGED from its inception has been organizing training courses for its officers and staff in a decentralized approach. Training is organized not only in Dhaka but also in Division and Regions and site offices. Training Courses for the beneficiaries and local stakeholders are held locally at sites. Along with formal training courses, on–the-job training is given more importance as people learn by doing.

The training calendar (FY 2016-17) will give a clear picture of the training courses under the revenue budget as well as courses under the development fund. The training information, such as-course title, events of each course, category of participants, duration (days), total participants, trainee-days, tentative allocation, venue and dates etc. are available under various columns. A format showing venue, date and course has been included in the Training Plan which can be used by Training unit or project to prepare a supplementary calendar of their own.

I hope that Training Unit and projects will implement their respective training courses in time effectively and efficiently.

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Introduction

The Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) has given emphasis on training from its inception. Training activities under various programme started under the former Works programme Wing in 1982. Initially, Institutional Support Project (ISP) under Rural Development Project-4 (RDP-4) conducted training programme of the then LGEB (Local Government Engineering Bureau) Gradually, training activities gained a real momentum and an institutional shape was given. A Central Training Unit (CTU) was established at LGED Head Quarters in Dhaka in 2003. 14 Regional Training Centres (RTC) were established under revenue budget in 2012 in each of the 14 regions of LGED headed by a Superintending Engineer (Region). The locations of RTCs are Dhaka, Mymensingh, Faridpur, Khulna, jessore, Barisal, Patuakhali, Rajshahi, Bogra, Rangpur, Dinajpur, Sylhet, Chittagongand Comilla.

The prime objective of LGED Training Unit is to develop capacity of LGED officials and staff through training. Training activities include assessment of training need, development of training modules and implementation of training courses followed by evaluation. The training courses are implemented not only at LGED HQ but also at the region, district, upazila and union level depending on the target participants and the types of training. All the categories of employees, LGI representatives, stakeholders like contractors, LCS and project beneficiaries associated with the developmentworks are covered under training program. Training Unit develops in-house trainers through imparting Training of Trainers (TOT) course.

The training courses funded from the revenue budgets are mainly designed for the LGED officials. The project specific training courses are funded from the developmentprojects and aredesigned for the LGED and project officials, LGI representatives, contractors and other concerned persons for smooth implementation of the project. These courses are implemented by the projects with support from the training unitas required. Other than these, some training courses are also conducted with the fund from the Local Government Division on request.

Each training course is evaluated during and after the accomplishment of the course which helps to modify and upgrade the courses. Provisions for pre and post tests are kept to assess the level of competency and development of the trainees. Trainers' skills are also evaluated through feedback from the participants. Effectiveness of the trainings is measured by external evaluation team after certain interval.

A training calendar is prepared for each Fiscal Year to conduct training efficiently and effectively. This calendar includes both revenue and development budget trainings. It also includes the achievement of previous year's training and plan for the current year. In FY 2015-16 BDT 40crore was spent which is 85% of the budget allocation. This achieves 1286779 trainee-days. For FY 2016-17 BDT 41.05 crore is allocated to carry out trainings under different courses to achieve 863457 trainee-days.

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
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
